Winner: Riva Domino 86

Mauro Micheli, a regular contributor to the modern Riva look, designed this very seductive and forward-thinking new model, whose lines reveal the Domino 86's winning spirit but are not overly aggressive. The Domino 86 is particularly attractive in its metallic ice finish. The designer has made the flybridge as discreet as possible by, among other things, foregoing the windscreen.



Best

Winner: Lazzara LSX 92

Lazzara Yachts continues to innovate. Here the builder pushed the envelope further with quadruple Volvo Penta IPS900s. Lazzara's in-house design team has taken advantage of all the extra space the IPS units allow to integrate features usually found on much larger yachts. Among these are a sauna and a terrace off of the master suite and a beach club aft.



Innov

Winner: Baia 100

The Baia 100 is groundbreaking in many ways. The dining room, forward of the pilothouse, is under an immense glass canopy that features a central door, which lifts up to open a direct passage to the great foredeck. The salon's aft door in the open position disappears completely, allowing interior and exterior areas to blend in one continuous space.
